Roman Kagarlitsky, CEO

Roman Kagarlitsky, an Angel Investor and CEO of RenderX, started his career in the U.S. as an Analog Engineer at KarKar Electronics, then worked at HP Labs (Agilent) as a member of the technical staff. Kagarlitsky left HP Labs to pursue various entrepreneurial and investment opportunities. In 1996 he co-founded Pluris, Inc. - Terabit-router Company, where he was an interim CEO, funded initial development, created the business plan, raised private and angel funds and later brought in venture capital firms. In 1997 Kagarlitsky left Pluris. Total investment into Pluris over life of the company added to a total amount of \$218M. Thereafter Kagarlitsky funded Optoelectronic Components and the GaAs/III-V Process Design Company and RenderX. Kagarlitsky received his MS in Electrical Engineering and BS in Mechanical Science in the former USSR.

Kevin Brown, VP of Sales

Bringing over twenty years of experience in the information technology and management industry, Kevin Brown is now the vice president of sales for RenderX.
